Daily Advancement – What is a Poniard?



When Bro. Dennis Vaughan was admitted, he had a poniard presented to his naked left breast, as is the custom for all initiates. The symbolism is naturally explained later, but what is a poniard? To many of us we have never heard the term and essentially it is a similar to a parrying dagger.

It is a long, lightweight, slender thrusting knife with a continuously tapering, acutely pointed blade with a cross guard. This type of knife was traditionally worn by the nobility and upper classes, particularly members of the knighthood and men of honour.

The poniard emerged during the middle ages and they are rarely seen today outside of Museums and Freemasonry!
