Chapter



Daily Advancement

The Rite of Circumambulation



Fear not this is not some new physical ritual that you have to endure, however it is something you have already done!

When the deacon conducts a candidate around the lodge room accompanied by the Deacons (which is always squared in St Nicholas Lodge) it's interesting to know that when the candidate stands after the prayer, they are about to begin part of a very old ceremony.

This is known as the Rite of Circumambulation and it can be traced back to many ancient civilisations, it actually is meant to symbolically follow the route of the sun, starting from the Worshipful Master in the East, to the Junior Warden in the South and finally ending at the Senior Warden in the West.

In the early days Masonic Lodges had a space, called the outer path around the edge along which the candidate would be led to each gate (guarded by a Warden). After his reception at each gate he was allowed onto the floor of the lodge where he would be conducted around the inner path, to show that he was properly prepared.

The role of the Wardens is then emphasised as they guarded the paths and only candidates who had passed along **both** paths could be presented to the Worshipful Master. At an initiation the Warden is given a firm and reassuring handshake and is then passed on 'free and of good report'.

After the circumambulation is concluded it is the Senior Warden in the West who announces that the Candidate is 'properly prepared' and can now advance to the East, and to the light, in due form.

The staggered steps of 9, 12 & 15 inches are meant to symbolise that each step will carry him further forward than the last, showing his will to go forward and demonstrating his trust and confidence.
